The timetable is indicative only. If the exhibitor does not enter the ring on time, he cannot show the dog on display. Owners of dogs awarded the "BOB" title are required to participate with their dogs in the final show of winners!

Owner of dog awarded the "BIS" title is required to participate with this dog in the final show on 12.10.2025 – SUPREME BIS!!

Entries:

Entries via the online system DOGOFFICE only: http://www.dogoffice.cz/

Due to limited space of the showground the organizer has all the rights to close the entries while maximum number of dogs – 420 dogs per show day – will be reached.

Each user must have their personal account set up in the system. In the section "My dogs" you will establish your dogs and attach to them the necessary attachments (Pedigree of both parties, including the party where the owner is listed, champion certificate or working certificate …). The owner registered in the pedigree must be the same as the username of the account in dogoffice.cz, if the dog is co-owned, an account in the dogoffice.cz must be established under the same names. Creating an account will also serve you to register for other shows in the Czech Republic.

If the entry is missing attached photocopy of proof that the dog meets the conditions for the working or champion class, will be placed in the open class.

Entries sent after 22.09.2025, unpaid entries and entries without a copy of proof of payment will not be accepted!! Entries that are insufficiently paid (e.g. incorrect price) will not be accepted!!

The organizer reserves the right to cancel unpaid entries without urgency.

The organizer reserves the right to reject the application without giving a reason.

A dog can only be entered in one class.

Entry forms are available in the system www.dogoffice.cz about 3-5 days before the exhibition.

If you cancel the entry before II.deadline (24.08.2025), we will refund your entry fee with a deduction of the handling fee -30% of your paid entry fees. If you cancel the entry before III.deadline (22.09.2025), we will refund your entry fee with a deduction of the handling fee -50% of your paid entry fees. It is not possible to cancel the entry after III.deadline. Change of class is possible for a fee 10 EUR before III.deadline (22.09.2025).

Definition of classes:

Division into classes is governed by Show Regulation of ČMKU and FCI and is indicated in the entry form. Awarding of titles is not compulsory.

- 1. Veteran class from 8 years will be judge as a first class
- 2. Baby class 4 6 months the best four are being placed in each class, 1st to 4th
- 3. Puppy class 6 9 months the best four are being placed in each class, 1st to 4th
- 4. Junior class 9 18 months
- 5. Intermediate class 15 24 months

- **6. Open class** from 15 months
- 7. Working class from 15 months, for dogs that have passed a working certificate under FCI.
- 8. Winner class from 15 months, for dogs that have been confirmed a champion under FCI, with titles National Winner, Club Winner, Winner of Specialty Club Show, European Winner, World Winner from adult classes
- **9. Honour class** from 15 months, for dogs that have been confirmed a champion under FCI, with titles National Winner, Club Winner, Winner of Specialty Club Show, European Winner, World winner from adult classes class without title

In classes: junior, intermediate, open, working, winner, veteran, honour - the best four with either Excellent or Very Good grades are being placed.

- **Best Progeny group** competiton of at least 5 offspring that were judged at the show. The type and quality of breeding is being judged.
- Best Couple competition of male and female of the same breed that were judged at the show and are owned by one owner
- Best Breeder's group competition of 3-5 dogs of one breed from one kennel, from different litters (min. from two different fathers or mothers) that were judged at the show
- Best Minor Puppy competition of all minor puppies of all breeds that were awarded with 1st Very Promising
- Best Puppy competition of all puppies of all breeds that were awarded with 1st Very Promising
- Best Junior all dogs from junior classes of all breeds that were awarded with BOJ Best Junior
- Best Veteran all dogs from veteran classes of all breeds that were awarded with BOV Best Veteran
- Best Working all males and females from working classes of all breeds that were awarded with 1st Excellent, CAC
- Best Honour all males and females from honour classes of all breeds that were awarded with 1st Excellent
- BIS BOS all dogs of all breeds that were awarded with the title BOS
- BIS all dogs of all breeds that were awarded with the title BOB Best of Breed

Titles and expectancy in rings awarded within the each breed on 12.10.2025

- BIS Couple male and female of the same breed that were judged at the show and are owned by one owner
- BIS Breeder's group 3-5 dogs of one breed from one kennel, from different litters (min. from two different fathers or mothers) and were judged at the show
- BIS Minor Puppy all minor puppies of all breeds that were awarded with 1st Very Promising
- BIS Puppy all puppies of all breeds that were awarded with 1st Very Promising
- BIS Junior all dogs from junior classes of all breeds that were awarded with BOJ Best Junior
- BIS Veteran all dogs from veteran classes of all breeds that were awarded with BOV Best Veteran
- BIS Working all males and females from working classes of all breeds that were awarded with 1st Excellent, CAC

- BIS Honour all males and females from honour classes of all breeds that were awarded with 1st Excellent
- BIS BOS all dogs of all breeds that were awarded with the title BOS
- BIS all dogs of all breeds that were awarded with the title BOB Best of Breed
- SUPREME BIS selection between of the winners of both days- BIS from 11.10. and BIS from 12.10.2025

Owners of the dogs awarded the title BOB are obliged to participate with their dogs in the final competitions.

Documents for participation:

- dog's pedigree
- vaccination card (passport of a dog)
- entry confirmation

Veterinary conditions:

All entered dogs must be clinically healthy. Dogs must have pet passport or veterinary certificate with valid vaccination against rabies. Dogs from EU and third countries must have valid EU Pet Passport and must meet the conditions by the EU Regulation 998/2003 from 26/5/2003.

All the time during the dog show the owners must supervise / take care of the dogs so that they do not cause any damage to other dogs or humans.

General conditions:

The exhibition is accessible to males and females of all breeds registered in the books recognized by the FCI that reached the day of the show the age required for class. Organizers are not responsible for damages caused by a dog or an exhibitor, or for dog loss or death during the exhibition. The fairgrounds are not allowed to move freely dogs.

The exhibition will not be admitted dog with cropped ears and will not be judged. Show is not open for females in season, females in the second half of pregnancy, nursing females and aggressive individuals.

It is forbidden to treat the coat, skin or nose of the dog anything that changes their texture, color or shape. It is forbidden to treat the dog on the show grounds, using any substances or equipment. Allowed only cutting, trimming, combing and brushing. It is also forbidden to tie the dog on the table at the show. Violation of this provision may result in immediate expulsion from the show.

Exhibitors are required to comply with the provisions of the FCI Show Regulations and ČMKU, these propositions and the instructions of Show Committee.

Exhibitor acknowledges that it is required to maintain order in the exhibition area.

Taking puppies for sale at the show is prohibited.

At the show will be photographer to make photos for the needs of the show organiser. You as a exhibitor enter the breed ring knowing this information. The photos will be posted later on the show website or on the FB page. By signing and submitting the entry form, the exhibitor agrees to publication of his name and address in the show catalogue and on the web page of shows.

If the show does not take place due to force majeure, the fees will be used to cover the expenses.

Leaving the dog in a vehicle without human supervision - This is allowed only exceptionally and for a short time period. In this case, the dog must be provided with sufficient air, space or light, as well as a suitable ambient temperature (eg functional air conditioning in summer and heating in winter). Longer keeping the dog in a confined space of the vehicle can be considered as a cruelty.

Exhibitors at the ČMKU show are responsible for the welfare of dogs. It is forbidden to expose a dog to a situation that could endanger his health or well-being, such as leaving him in a vehicle for extraordinary heat or winter, respectively behave in a rough way. Violations of this Regulation will result in exclusions from the following exhibitions.

Complaints:

A complaint against any decision made by the judge is not admissible. A complaint can be submitted for formal reasons concerning violating the show regulation provisions and proposition provisions. The complaint must be submitted in writing, against a deposit 100 Euro only in time period of the show. If the complaint is found to be unjustified, this deposit will be handed over to the organiser of the show.
